The Rotary clubs of Citrus County continue to support Central Florida Community College with this year's donation of \$12,500 to the Promise for the Future Fund, for the Learning and Conference Center on the Citrus campus. This is the second installment on the pledge of \$50,000 from the Rotary clubs.

The new Learning and Conference Center adds much-needed space to meet the needs of Citrus County citizens engaged in degree, non-degree, corporate and lifelong learning, as well as adding a new meeting and conference space in the center of the county.

The new center encompasses multipurpose classrooms including a corporate training space with multimedia capabilities, a science lab and a state-of-the-art computer lab, as well as an executive conference room. The 5,000-sf exhibit and conference center can handle a single event or two simultaneous events.
