

## Supervisor of Elections Susan Gill Previews Amendments on November Ballot

Rotary Club of Inverness members and guests enjoyed an excellent presentation from Citrus County Supervisor of Elections Susan Gill on October 12. She distributed sample ballots, reviewed the state constitutional amendments and shared information on nonpartisan websites where voters can get more information to prepare for Early Voting, which begins next week, or election day of November 2.

Gill also discussed the shifting voting patterns she has seen since taking office. She said that with each election cycle, more voters are taking advantage of the convenient options of early voting and absentee ballots. Now it is possible for candidates to have received enough votes prior to election day to be elected, but votes are counted only after the polls close on election day, with results being available at that time.
